PART TWO TUTORIAL

Part Two is decidedly more challenging than Part One. Gauge your audience. If they are into puzzles and logic games, they will enjoy this. But, if at any time, you feel like players are getting frustrated, read this tutorial aloud. If they're still stuck, reference the hints. And finally, don't feel bad if you need to peek at one or two of the answers on page 404. This is meant to be a fun, social experience. I don't want people feeling down on themselves. If all else fails, skip to the final part with the four "finish" choux and brute-force your way (i.e. eat everything) to find the choux with blue food dye.

- Start with EAT, since we know that is what Leo got.
- Leo can tell everyone that it's in the Choc-Mint column.
- Ray also got something with Choc-Mint.
- Not only did Ray have something with Choc-Mint, but their shell was the same as Leo's. In fact that's the only thing the two of them have in common, so all their other letters can't match. This means Ray can't have GIN, since no letters match EAT.
- You know Ray's word contains 'S' in it because of the Chocolate Icing.
- Look at all the codenames remaining for Ray.
- Ray's word must be SAM. And therefore the Plain Shell filled with Choc-Mint must be the letter 'A' – the only letter SAM and EAT have in common.
- In the Choc-Mint column, the 'A' is filled with green colour. The Plain Shell with Choc-Cinnamon Inside is also green, so it must also be 'A'.
- The Gold Decoration with Choc-Mint Inside must be 'E'. That is blue colour, so all other blues on the other grids must also be 'E'.
