Congratulations, amis!

You have proven your bravery, received your agent code names and joined the Resistance along with many others — both in occupied France and around the world. My heart jumps at the thought of my fellow countrymen and women heeding the call to action against our Nazi occupiers.

Sadly, my joy has been tempered at some troubling news within our own ranks. For fear of making the situation worse, I cannot openly disclose exactly what has been troubling me. Suffice it to say, I have instead sent you a new code that, if broken and heeded, will prove each of you loyal to our cause.

Agents, each of you has been sent a three-letter code word in the form of a single choux (or cream puff). You have also been sent six different letters with information relevant to revealing your personal three-letter code word. I didn't dare send everything together, as it would be too suspicious. Nevertheless, I expect everyone to work together as you did before you officially became agents. There is no reason to withhold information from your fellow agents.

As such, I have also sent the group three grids to help you figure out the code with as much information in it as I can dare to include. You must fill out the rest of the grids as much as you can. Some common letters appear more than once in the code; these are noted using matching colours. Otherwise, each letter only appears once. Once you know your flavour, use the grid specific to your flavour. Words can have their letters scrambled within your flavour grid. Use pens and paper to help you compare what you received. Mark down what choux you received before it disappears into your stomach.

My message will tell you which one of you needs to be in the specified location at the proper date and time. Once they're there, that person will receive the final choux selection. You, as a team, will decide which choux they should eat to prove everyone's loyalty and assuage my fears.

Only by eating these delectable clues and working out the words they represent can you and your five friends prove your loyalty to the Allies and facilitate the liberation of Western Europe.

With that in mind, let us begin:

Agent 1, your code word is the word "EAT."

Everyone eat your choux, now! Pay attention to what you're eating, but eat quickly, before the Nazis can confiscate the evidence. Stay vigilant, stay true. Vive la Resistance!

Your code word is the time of day the meeting needs to take place.

My typical day starts at 4am when the CAT sits on my head to wake me up. After some purrs and breakfast, I take the DOG for a walk at 5am and then start work as soon as I'm done. The morning crowd is usually gone by 11am and I can have some TEA. I leave the shop at 3pm and the rest of the DAY is mine to spend how I will. I usually SUP at 6pm and go to BED at 9pm.

Your code word is one of your fellow teammates' codenames. You should be able to find out all six codenames by talking to everyone.

Your code word is a location. Ask everyone where they live to find the six possible options for your choux.



AGENT 5: [_ _ _]

15 RUE Alsace Lorraine

Pâtisserie-sur-Mer

Your code word is a day of the week when we should meet.

Saturday is a BAD day for me. That's because there's always more people in the store and it's so busy I don't get any time off. We run out of pastries sometimes and then the customers get upset at me and yell. I close the shop on Sunday so I can go to Church to give my respects to GOD. I PAY all my employees on Thursday. And all orders for the weekend are DUE on Friday. My favourite day is WEDnesdays when it's quietest in the store and I can experiment with new recipes.



AGENT 6: [_ _ _]

Hotel de SEAside
86 Avenue de la République,
Pâtisserie-sur-Mer

Your code word tells you the allegiance of the person going to the meeting. They might not be friendly to the Resistance!

If you know they are a friend or AMI, then when the time comes the agent must eat the word WIN. If the person is a SPY, they need to eat DIE, which will mean they've accepted to double cross the Nazis and start working for the Resistance instead.

If you choose correctly, then their tongue will turn blue. Show me a blue tongue and I'll know I can trust you all.
